

installation, and the vehicle on which the tire was originally installed. Your original invoice when you purchase the tire should contain this information. You are responsible for payment for any extra products, services or upgrades that you request that are not covered by the limited warranty or warranty allowances.

The vehicle on which Power King tires are installed should be properly maintained, aligned, operated safely and the tires must be properly inflated and used within tire load and speed limits.

IMPORTANT SAFETY WARNINGS AND INFORMATION

Power King commercial highway tire owners should follow these safety tips to avoid serious accident and injury:

- Tires intended for on-highway use should never be used off-highway because off-highway use exposes tires to hazards and stress for which the tires were not designed or manufactured. Sudden and catastrophic failure may occur.
- Tire under-inflation, over-inflation or overloading can cause tire failure (You must adhere to directions in the manufacturer's owner's manual or tire placard in the vehicle for proper tire pressures for the front and rear tires).
- Be sure that all of the tire valve caps are present and securely attached. The valve cap is one of the primary seals against air leaks.
- Tires should be mounted and balanced only by specially trained dealer personnel.
- Match the tire's diameter with the wheel rim's bead seat diameter (for example, a 15-inch tire must only be mounted on a 15-inch wheel).
- Inflation pressure should be checked using an accurate tire gauge at least once a month. Check pressure when the tire is cool; never bleed hot tires as it may lead to under-inflation after cooling; and never allow children to check, inflate or deflate tires.
- Before towing a trailer, check with your dealer to determine proper tire sizing and pressures that may be required because of the trailer load.
- Check tires frequently for cuts, bulges, abnormal or uneven wear, abrasions, glass, or metal debris and impact damage.
- Repairs to tires must follow Rubber Manufacturers Association standards and, if permitted, should always consist of a plug combined with a patch applied to the inside of the tire when the tire is removed from the wheel; plug repairs with an internal patch are improper and prone to leaks and sudden failures.
- Avoid road hazards, debris, curbs and potholes, which can damage your tires, wheels and alignment.
- Never over-inflate your tire, and never exceed the maximum pressure and load molded in the tire sidewall. Only inflate tire to maximum pressure when your tires are carrying the maximum load.

- Have tire punctures repaired by the trained personnel at a Power King dealer.
- If your vehicle is stuck in snow, mud, sand or is impeded by a physical obstruction, such as a ditch, avoid excessive tire spinning; never exceed 35 miles an hour on the odometer when spinning a tire, as the centrifugal force generated above that speed could result in tire deformation or explosion. Instead, use gentle forward and backward motion to free the vehicle.
- Best tire performance is achieved when all tires are of the same type and the size that is recommended by the vehicle manufacturer for the particular axle. Never mount radial ply tires on the same axle as non-radial ply tires; never mount radial tires on the front axle when non-radial tires are mounted on the rear axle as these conditions can create vehicle instability resulting in sudden loss of control, damage and injury.
- It is recommended that all four (4) tires on a commercial vehicle be replaced at the same time. However, when only two (2) tires are replaced, the new tires should be installed on the rear axle to achieve better driving performance and safety.
- Never drive on tires that have less than 2/32nds of an inch of tread remaining; replace tires as soon as the tread reaches the treadwear indicators molded into the tread grooves of the tire, which reveal when the tread depth remaining is 2/32nds of an inch. Continued use creates a serious risk of tire failure, loss of control and serious injury.
- ***Never operate your vehicle at speeds above that posted or speeds that are not justified by the road conditions.***

Please call TBC Brands warranty toll-free number at: 1-800-238-6469. Please be prepared to provide proof of purchase of the product and purchase date. Our Product Warranty Specialist will confirm the coverage of the Power King limited warranty and discuss your tire issue with you. They will find a Power King dealer nearest to you whom you may take your Power King tire to for inspection and any applicable warranty adjustment. TBC Brands will work with the tire dealer to supply a replacement Power King tire or comparable tire in an efficient manner.

The authorized dealer has no authority or responsibility to make the determination as to eligibility for coverage under the warranty.

Applies To Tires Purchased On Or After July 1, 2009

ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible for the benefits of this Power King® Off-Highway Limited Warranty if you are the original owner of a new Power King® Off-Highway tire, if this tire has been continuously installed on the vehicle on which it was originally installed and no warranty exclusion or exception applies. This Limited Power King Tire Warranty covers new Power King® Off-Highway tires (R4, I-3, NHS) purchased and installed on a vehicle in the United States or Canada, and used according to the vehicle or equipment manufacturer's recommendations. Off-Highway tires are designed principally for specialized service in other-than-normal highway operation (such as farm and industrial tires) and do not bear Department of Transportation (DOT) prescribed identification numbers. This limited warranty does not cover tires marked "NO ADJ" or "NA" (non-adjustable).

LIMITED WARRANTY AGAINST DEFECTS IN WORKMANSHIP AND MATERIALS

If any Power King Off-Highway tire covered by this limited warranty becomes unserviceable within sixty (60) months from the date of installation by reason of a defect in workmanship or material, an authorized Power King dealer will repair it or make an allowance on the purchase price of a new equivalent Power King tire or a comparable new replacement tire. The Power King servicing dealer will decide what is the best course under the circumstances. You pay for the price of the replacement tire, after any warranty allowance is applied, the cost of the mounting and balancing, and any applicable taxes.

Your Power King tire will be replaced with a new Power King tire or comparable tire marketed by TBC Brands without charge for the tire and mounting if the tire fails due to a defect in workmanship or materials during the first twelve (12) months following installation and no more than ten percent (10%) of the original tread depth has been used when presented. However, if your tire fails due to a defect in workmanship or materials after the applicable no-charge replacement period or the tread use exceeds that allowed, you will be entitled to a prorated allowance applicable to the purchase price of a comparable new Power King tire or other comparable tire brand marketed by TBC Brands. Your replacement tire allowance will be prorated based on the date of manufacture and the amount of tire use after it was installed. This use is calculated by determining the percentage of original useable tread depth on the new Power King tire installed on your vehicle that has been used when the tire is presented for replacement and adjustment. You will also be responsible for the cost of mounting the replacement tire and the taxes applicable to the prorated amount as well as for that of any other services you require at that time. The adjustment schedule for tires after twelve months of service or when more than ten percent of tread use remains is as follows:

Tire Installed	Original Tread Depth Used	Adjustment Allowance
Less than 12 months	No more than 10%	100%
Less than 24 months	No more than 20%	75%
Less than 36 months	No more than 40%	50%
Less than 48 months	No more than 60%	30%
Less than 60 months	No more than 80%	10%

DEFINITION OF A COMPARABLE TIRE

A new “comparable” tire will be supplied under this warranty if a matching new Power King tire is out of production or is unavailable when the original tire is presented for warranty replacement. In such case, a warranty replacement tire may be substituted that is of equal price, quality and construction, and a suitable match to the other tires installed on your vehicle. A comparable tire may, however, have a different sidewall or tread configuration. If the purchaser requests a higher-priced replacement tire instead, the purchaser must pay the price difference for the “upgrade” after the appropriate prorated allowance for the comparable the tire has been deducted.

COMPUTING TREAD DEPTH

The amount of the original tread depth of each new Power King tire varies and depends on its type and size. The Purchaser will be informed by the Power King dealer of the original tread depth of the tire purchased when presented for warranty replacement and adjustment. The original tread depth does not include the last 2/32nd inch of tread depth because it is not usable for safety reasons and is deducted to determine tread use. Because tires do not always wear evenly, tread depth may vary depending where the tire’s tread depth is measured. The lowest depth on the tire is used to determine the amount of original tread used for purposes of warranty replacement and adjustment.

LIMITED DEFECT WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS

This Limited Warranty applies to defects in material and workmanship during manufacture and does not cover other tire damage caused by use of the tire that is unrelated to such defects. This section should be read carefully because it may determine whether you are entitled to a warranty replacement or adjustment allowance. The limited warranty against defects in material and workmanship provided herein does not apply if one or more of the exclusions and limitations set forth above or in this section below are applicable. Your limited warranty protection from defects in material and workmanship does not apply if the tire is damaged due to:

- Road hazards such as impacts, cuts, snags or punctures
- Self-vulcanizing plug repairs, improper section repairs or repair in a manner that does not comply with Rubber Manufacturers Association standards
- Ozone or weather checking more than four years from date of manufacture
- Improper inflation pressure or overloaded conditions
- Vandalism, theft, long-term improper storage or other abuse
- Improper mounting or de-mounting procedures, or rim slip
- Mismatching of adjacent tires or misapplications
- Over- and under- inflation, overloading or failure to maintain proper tire pressure
- Addition of liquids, solids or gases (other than air, nitrogen, carbon dioxide) such as sealers, balancing materials or fillers
- Mechanical failures of the vehicle on which the tire is installed and vehicle wheel misalignment

- Defective or failed wheel on which the tire is mounted
- Over/under- sized tubes or use of old tubes with new tire installation
- Improper repair or use of sealants or other non-approved materials
- Tread chunking

NOTE: THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC RIGHTS, WHICH VARY FROM STATE TO STATE. SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGE OR HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY MAY LAST, SO CERTAIN LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSIONS HEREIN MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. HOWEVER, TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY THE LAWS OF YOUR STATE, TBC BRANDS DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED OTHER THAN THE WARRANTIES STATED IN THIS LIMITED WARRANTY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR OTHERWISE IS LIMITED IN DURATION AND EXPIRES WHEN THE TIRE’S USEABLE TREAD IS EXHAUSTED AS SPECIFIED IN THIS LIMITED WARRANTY. TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER, AND EXPRESSLY EXCLUDES, ANY COVERAGE OR LIABILITY FOR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, FOR LOSS OF TIME, INCONVENIENCE, LOSS OF USE OF YOUR VEHICLE OR TIRE, LOST PROFITS OR ANY OTHER INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES. THIS IS THE ONLY WARRANTY THAT APPLIES TO THE POWER KING TIRES PURCHASED BY YOU AND SUPERSEDES AND REPLACES THE TERMS OF ANY PREVIOUS WARRANTY. NOTHING IN THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS INTENDED TO BE A REPRESENTATION THAT TIRE FAILURES CANNOT OCCUR. TBC BRANDS NEITHER ASSUMES NOR EXTENDS, NOR AUTHORIZES ANY OTHER PERSON OR ENTITY TO ASSUME OR EXTEND ON ITS BEHALF, ANY OTHER OR DIFFERENT WARRANTY OBLIGATION.

ORIGINAL PURCHASER’S OBLIGATIONS

To make a claim under this Limited Power King Warranty, you must be the original purchaser and you must present the warranted tire to an authorized Power King tire dealer for adjustment along with the following items: proof of purchase showing that you purchased the tire, the date of purchase and
